# Carrots



## Purple Dragon

G103001

Tapering roots with a reddish-purple skin and yellow-orange core. up to 22 cm long and are ready for harvest approximately 80 days after sowing

# Cucumber



## Honey Plus

G105001

Small size (7 until 10 cm) pale green smooth skinned cucumbers. Fruits in 40 days and can give up to 20 until 25 fruits with a sweet crunchy flavour.

## Party Time

G105002

Resistance: Powdery and downy mildew

Parthenocarpic snack size (10 cm) cucumbers. Smooth dark green skin with crunchy flavour. 4 fruits per week and first harvest after 45 days.

## Merlin

G105003

Resistance: Powdery mildew and tolerant to downy mildew and cucumber mosaic virus.

Parthenocarpic midi size (15 cm) cucumber. Early maturing plant with high yield, 2 fruits per node every few days.

# Coocking Cucumber



## **Prolific / Brocade**

G107001

Resistance: highly resistance to powdery mildew

A productive and versatile variety originating from South East Asia, locally known as Sambar Southekai. The indeterminate plants produce green, ovoid fruits with yellow striping, 20–25 cm long, maturing in 45 days.

## **Sundrop / Yellow Ball**

G107002

Resistance: highly resistance to powdery and downy mildew

A distinctive cucurbit from the Karnataka region of India, where it is traditionally known as 'Dosekai. Vigorous indeterminate plants produce mid-sized, spherical yellow fruits measuring 11–14 cm in diameter

# Eggplant



## **White Knight**

G101001

A variety producing slender, creamy-white, 20 cm fruits with thin skins and firm flesh. Compact, early-maturing plants reach around 75 cm in height. This reliable variety offers good yields and strong disease resistance.

## **Violet Knight**

G101002

A variety producing high yields of slender, banana-shaped fruits with smooth, deep purple skin. Compact and early to mature plants. Reliable performance is matched by good disease resistance and consistent cropping.

## Green Knight

G101003

Produces slender, jade-green fruits with firm flesh and a mild, sweet flavour. This early-maturing variety yields high-quality fruits around 17 cm long on compact, well-branching plants with good disease resistance.

# Melon



## Budgie

G109001

Resistance: Powdery and downy mildew

A honeydew melon with a neat, bushy growth habit. It produces around four yellow-skinned fruits weighing 1.5–2kg. The cream-coloured flesh is sweet and refreshing, with a high sugar content and Brix levels of 14–15%.

## Lottie

G109002

Resistance: Downy mildew

Classic cantaloupe produces lightly netted fruits with deep orange flesh. Sweet flavour, the flesh reaches a Brix level of around 15% for rich flavour. Bushy plants yield 4–5 fruits per plant, each weighing 1.5–2.0 kg

## Honey Bun

G109003

This unique bush cantaloupe has round fruits which measure 12–14 cm across and have deep orange flesh with a rich, honey-sweet flavour. Each plant produces 3–4 fruits and reaches height of max 100 cm.

# Okra



## Super Bhindi

G110002

An early, prolific variety ideally suited to greenhouse growing and performs reliably in Northern European conditions. Well-branched plants reach around 1.5 m and produce abundant deep-green, smooth, spineless pods best harvested at 7–10 cm for tenderness.

## Bhut Bhindi

G110001

Tall plants reach up to 1.5 m and produce striking creamy-white pods and large white flowers, offering a unique alternative to green okra.

# Sweet Pepper



## Afterglow

G111001

A high-yielding variety with fruits that ripen from green to bright yellow-orange. The thick-walled, tapered peppers have a crisp bite and a sweet, versatile flavour. Compact plants are ideal for containers and smaller gardens, delivering reliable crops of colourful fruit.

## Panache

G111002

Sweet Pepper 'Panache' is a vigorous, high-yielding variety producing large, thick-walled fruits with a crunchy, sweet flavour. Best grown in warm, sunny conditions, it performs particularly well in greenhouses and containers.

## Bellrouge

G111004

A heavy-yielding variety producing thick, fleshy fruits with a sweet, citrusy flavour. Versatile and quick to mature, the peppers are ideal for roasting, sauces, or fresh eating, turning from green to red at full ripeness.

## Popti

G111003

An ideal choice for containers or small gardens, producing around 10 fruits per compact plant. The peppers ripen early from dark green to deep red, with crispy, juicy flesh and a fresh, slightly sweet flavour.

## Lycobell

G111008

Resistance: ToMV

A strong, vigorous sweet pepper variety producing firm, square blocky fruits. The deep glossy red peppers weigh 200–220 gr. on average and offer excellent shelf life.

## Orobell

G111009

Resistance: TMV

A strong, vigorous sweet pepper variety producing firm, square blocky fruits. The deep glossy yellow peppers weigh 200–220 gr. on average and offer excellent shelf life.

## Amarilla

G111010

A semi-erect sweet pepper variety producing smooth, light green fruits measuring 14 × 1.8 cm. Known for its long shelf life, the fruits maintain excellent keeping quality after harvest. Ideal for fresh market sales or home gardening, it combines attractive appearance with reliable performance.

# Hot Pepper



## Mirch-Masala

G112001

A vigorous, semi-erect variety producing pendulous, deep-red fruits around 10 cm long. Selected for high pungency, disease resistance, and adaptability, The well-branched plants is also ornamental

## Sparky

G112002

A compact, spreading variety producing masses of 1 cm long, bright red fruits. Mildly hot with a distinctive flavour, Plants also have a high ornamental value.

## Toofan

G112003

A vigorous, semi-erect variety producing masses of 10–12 cm upward-facing fruits. Ripening from green to bright scarlet red, the medium-hot peppers. Compact and well-branched, the plants reach 75–90 cm and are easy to grow.

## Hungarian Black

G112004

It has a stunning colour palette, with fruits ripening from green through deep purple to bright red. Compact plants up to 1m, with lilac-blue flowers, purple-speckled leaves, maturing after 75 days.

## Reggae

G112005

A compact, well-branched variety producing 8–10 cm long, very hot pendulous fruits. With around 100,000 SHU and can be harvested green or red. The plants mature in about 100 days.

# Tomato



## Merrygold

G118001

Resistance: Highly resistance late blight and phytophthora

A high-yielding cherry tomato producing bright orange, firm fruits weighing 20–30 g. The early-ripening fruits are sweet and tangy, with a robust skin and excellent flavour.

## Cherry Falls

G118002

A compact, determinate hanging variety ideal for pots, baskets, and small spaces. It produces abundant clusters of sweet, bright-red cherry tomatoes (2–3 cm, 12–15 g). The fruits ripen early in the season.

## Prosperiant

G118003

Resistance: intermediate TOMV, highly to mildew

A productive hybrid Roma variety with a bushy habit and clustered crops. The firm, olive-shaped fruits weigh 100–120 g and are ideal for coulis, sauces, and preserves.

## Delicious

G118004

A large, scarlet-red beefsteak variety with rich flavour and meaty, low-seed flesh. Fruits weigh on average 500 g but can reach record-breaking sizes up to 3.5 kg. Indeterminate, crack-resistant plants produce high yields about 80 days after germination.

## Cherokee Purple

G118005

A classic heirloom beefsteak variety producing large, round, slightly flattened fruits around 300 g with a rich, sweet flavor. The deep dusky purple-pink fruits are grown on indeterminate plants reaching 1.2–1.8 m, maturing in approximately 80 days.

## Brandy Wine

G1118006

A historic heirloom beefsteak variety producing large, meaty fruits weighing 200–500 g with a rich, “heavenly” flavor. The indeterminate plants mature in around 90 days and deliver exceptional harvests.

## White Cherry

G1118007

A striking ivory-white to pale yellow cherry tomato with sweet, fruity flavor. The vigorous, disease-resistant plants can grow up to 3 m and produce abundant fruits about 65 days after transplanting.

## Red Currant

G1118008

Tiny, round red fruits about 1–1.3 cm in diameter with a sweet-tart flavor and firm, juicy texture. High-yielding plants bear large clusters on vigorous, cordon-trained branches, making harvesting easy.

## Green Zebra

G118009

An indeterminate variety producing striking green-and-yellow striped fruits about 5–7 cm in diameter with a sweet, tangy flavor. The vigorous, high-yielding plants mature around 80 days after transplanting.

## Gold Rush

G118010

A variety with compact growth and excellent flavour. It produces heavy trusses of 10–12 small, golden-yellow, grape-sized, sweet tomatoes. Ready to harvest about 75 days after transplanting.

## **Rubylicious**

G118011

Resistance: Phytophthora, blight resistance

An outstanding cherry tomato combining modern blight resistance with old-fashioned sweetness. The vigorous cordon plants produce abundant trusses of up to 12–25 orangey-red fruits of 15–20 g, ideal for outdoor growing

## **Patio Plum**

G118013

A charming, determinant, compact tomato with distinctive crinkled dark-green leaves and an upright, tidy growth habit. The plants stay low (60–80 cm), producing clusters of olive-shaped fruits that ripen from green to bright red.
